MEETING IN PORTUGAL

In this meeting 39 representatives from each of the partner schools were present in Portugal:

- Croatia: 5 students (2 boys and 3 girls - one with special needs) and 3 teachers
- Estonia: 4 students (2 boys and 2 girls) and 2 teachers
- Italy: 5 students (2 boys and 3 girls) and 2 teachers
- Norway: 4 students (2 boys and 2 girls) and 2 teachers
- Poland: 4 students (2 boys and 2 girls) and 2 teachers
- Turkey: 4 students (2 boys and 2 girls) and 2 teachers

The arrival in Póvoa de Varzim took place on March 13, Sunday. All teams gathered at the Grande Hotel da Póvoa (where most of the teachers were lodged). At 17:00 it was held a meeting /coffee break with the hosting families and the new arrival students and teachers. Everyone received a folder with the Agenda and explanations about the week activities. After some questions and welcoming by the Portuguese team there was a moment of free conversation.

Twelve families collaborated with the project and each welcomed two students in their homes, taking responsibility for their travel to and from school during the meeting and the meals (except breakfast and lunch).
